## Texas Region

### RUN-WALK SUPPORTS CHAPLAINCY \$14,000+ RAISED



In January of 2022, National Church Residences launched the Chaplaincy Program in the growing market of Texas where we serve 40 different communities across the state. Our growth in Texas was celebrated on December 10, 2022 with our first major fundraising event to focus on the Chaplaincy program and how it offers spiritual, social and emotional support to our low-income Texas seniors. With widespread lack of familial support, many of our seniors face depression, loneliness and isolation. Volunteer Chaplains offer compassion, support and guidance to our residents when they need it most.



Iconic Woodlawn Lake Park in San Antonio served as a backdrop for this family friendly event where participants and volunteers were encouraged to dress up like reindeer or their favorite holiday personality and show off their running and walking skills.

Over 100 walkers and runners joined us to celebrate, and 20 sponsors and vendors helped make this day a success. The team, collectively, raised over \$14,000.

Participants enjoyed t-shirts, giveaways, a costume contest, a raffle, free, live entertainment and photos with Santa.

### VIDA FEST CONTINUES SENIOR FIESTA \$25,000+ RAISED

National Church Residences acquired a number of Texas Salvation Army senior communities in 2022. Two San Antonio-based former Salvation Army communities – now Woodlawn Pines and Ashby Arbor – celebrated an annual spring festival in conjunction with a larger Fiesta event across San Antonio each April, honoring the 1836 battles at The Alamo and at San Jacinto.

As one of the nation's most popular festivals, it has become crowded, large in scale and costly – making it difficult for our senior residents to attend. Vida Fests bring the “fiesta” right to their front door! Over the last 19 years, the senior-serving community has come together to sponsor this event, where our residents and the area senior and disabled adult community can enjoy their own party for free. The National Church Residences' Texas team along with more than 20 community partners continued this special event on April 25, 2023.

Our invited guests enjoyed live music, free food and drinks, live entertainment and their very own parade. The 2023 event marked the 20th year of celebrating this fun, community tradition.

## RISE 'N SHINE BRIGHTENS ATLANTA \$39,000+ RAISED

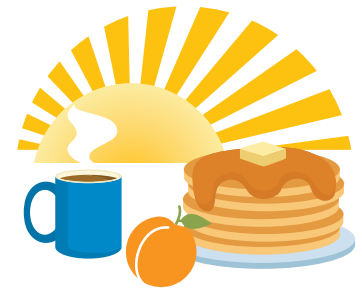

# GOLF CLASSIC

Though the weatherman predicted clouds and rain, the 12th Annual Golf Classic took place on July 17, 2023 under mostly sunny skies and cooler than normal temperatures. ## DONOR SPOTLIGHT

The 2023 Golf Classic was much like the other 11 before it: a successful day of golf on the Jack Nicklaus-designed Muirfield Village Golf Course, memories made, networking around the greens, cocktails and dinner after time on the celebrated course.

But the 2023 Golf Classic will always stand out in the minds of those present because of a remarkable gift so humbly made. Before introducing the evening's speaker, Archer Energy's president and CEO, Andy Mitrey, came to the podium and briefly shared thoughts about how he values his business relationship with National Church Residences. Then his story became more personal, as he talked to the audience about his family's journey with National Church Residences in 2020 in the midst of the coronavirus.

Andy described moving his aging parents to Columbus, how his father's health began to decline and the need to place him in a nursing facility where he didn't seem to be thriving. He shared that he turned to his colleagues at National Church Residences for help, and ultimately, moved his father into First Community Village's Healthcare Center, where his father began to stabilize. When his father was ready to take the next step in his life journey, Andy and his family turned to National Church Residences hospice.

Out of gratitude for the loving care his family received all along the way, Andy presented the Foundation with a check in the amount of \$100,000. It was a gracious gift that no one expected. There has never been such a moment at the Golf Classic dinner. We'll never forget the joy, the surprise and the gratitude we felt.

# RIDE FOR HOSPICE

Our Ride for Hospice event raises funds for National Church Residences Hospice Caregiver Support Fund. The fund provides specially trained helpers to families caring for a loved one on hospice at home, helping to alleviate caregiver burnout and prevent caregiver crisis.

### Second Annual Event

Flickenger Legal Group stepped to the plate again as title sponsor of the 2022 Ride for Hospice on September 17, 2022. No Cages Harley Davidson in Plain City, Ohio graciously offered their dealership space and their No Cares HOG Club to host the event and to lead the 70 bikers and their riders on a covered bridge ride throughout Union County. Forty volunteers and 21 sponsors assisted in the success of the ride – raising more than double the amount for 2021 at \$21,000!

### Third Annual Event

The June 2023 ride again was supported by Flickenger Legal Group and No Cages Harley Davidson as lead sponsor and host, respectively. Ninety riders traversed Union County to tour the area's covered bridges. Twenty-nine businesses and organizations sponsored the event, and 40 volunteers lent a hand to make the event a success. In addition, No Cages Harley Davidson chose Ride for Hospice as its charity of choice, giving proceeds from its summer Bike Nights to the Hospice Caregiver Support Fund. Proceeds of the 2023 event totaled more than \$25,000.

## National Equity Fund Grant Supports Programming

National Church Residences received a generous \$150,000 grant from the National Equity Fund (NEF) – a leading non-profit, multi-family, affordable, real estate investment manager whose mission is to create and deliver innovative, collaborative financial solutions to expand the creation and preservation of affordable housing. The grant supports programming at three National Church Residences properties: Clinton Place in Detroit, Michigan; Lakewood Christian in Atlanta, Georgia; and Carnegie Tower at Fairfax in Cleveland, Ohio. Each property will receive \$25,000 per year, for a two-year term.



The grant provides a gardening stipend, as well as funds for nutritional and exercise programs and cultural programs. Residents have been treated to spa days, trips to Amish Country in Ohio, a dinner cruise around the bay, healthy lunch programs, game nights, resident appreciation dinners, movie viewing, and even line dancing classes.

## Homemaker Services Provided by Grant from the City of Worthington

Since 2017, the City of Worthington has provided a grant to National Church Residences' Stafford Village in Worthington, Ohio. This grant provides \$3000 to be used for homemaker services for the residents at the property.

The resident service coordinator works directly with the property manager and the maintenance team to identify residents who may need extra help around the house. Homemaking services are then provided to those residents in partnership with National Church Residences' home and health wellness team of central Ohio.

The helpers come in and do tasks such as housecleaning, dishes, answering mail, small projects, and other tasks as needed. For many residents, the companionship provided by the helpers is the real treat of the day. The residents who participate in the program are so grateful for the extra help and the chance to stay in their residence living independently.

Our heartfelt appreciation goes out to the City of Worthington and their continued support of our most vulnerable residents.





## Grant Helps Seniors at Cotton Street Commons Engage with Modern Technology



The Stewards of Affordable Housing for the Future (SAHF) are an organization that advances policies and programs across the United States that help create and preserve thousands of homes with services each year. As such, they provide grants to organizations like National Church Residences for innovative programming that helps keep residents living independently longer. Our long-standing partnership with SAHF has resulted in numerous grants that help our residents thrive and improve their health and wellness. As part of their latest initiative, SAHF has provided a \$75,000 grant to Cotton Street Commons in Monroe,

North Carolina. The funds are to be used for a Digital Navigation program that will provide new tablets and educational materials for the residents, and tools for the service coordination team to help provide support to the residents. Additionally, the program will provide the assistance of a Digital Navigator that will work one-on-one with the residents to teach them how to sign up for the ACP program and how to use their new tablets.

The program is scheduled to last 18 months and is being spearheaded by National Church Residences' Digital Engagement Advisory Committee. This committee seeks to improve the lives of our seniors by providing them the equipment and resources to stay connected to today's modern world. With the help of partners like SAHF, National Church Residences can help our seniors engage with modern technology and thrive in their environment.



## Sensory Corner Enriches Life for Memory Care Residents



It was in July of 2022 when Nicole Papa, Foundation Director of the Water's Edge of Lake Wales Foundation, began sharing with residents about the opportunity to support the memory care program with their philanthropy. "It has been so thrilling to see our resident donors' eyes light up when we talked about the vision for a quiet space for our friends in memory care. A space where they feel safe and cozy. A place that appeals to all of the senses and is calming and relaxing," Nicole recalled.

Creating a Sensory Corner has been a passion of Christine Henry's since she became the Memory Care Life Enrichment Coordinator in 2022. Her vision was to create a space for relaxation and safety – and also, at times, a place for focused activities and stimulation of all the senses.



The project has truly been a partnership of staff and resident donors. With the help of two special matching funds opportunities provided by a donor living at Water's Edge of Lake Wales, the residents responded to Henry's vision and provided the gifts that made it a reality. The room was completed in April 2023 and was immediately put to use. A grand opening took place in July to share the Sensory Corner with the greater Lake Wales community and to showcase Snoezelen equipment and technology and a myriad of interactive features meant to engage residents with memory challenges.

## Stroll Run or Roll Events Move Forward

Our Stroll Run or Roll fundraising events are catching on! Residents, friends and area businesses have joined in the fun and raised money for favorite programs.

We held the first Stroll Run or Roll to benefit the programs of the Bristol Village Foundation in Waverly, Ohio and had 30 participants in 2021. In 2023, Bristol Village completed its third annual event with over 100 participants and many residents in action all three years.

In 2022, First Community Village Foundation held their first annual Stroll Run or Roll through the beautiful Upper Arlington campus with 51 participants.

These fundraising events are designed for EVERYONE! Whether someone wants to stroll, ride a golf cart, bicycle or scooter – or even sleep in – there is a chance to join with neighbors and friends and experience the joy of benefitting the Foundation wherever you call home, together.

In 2023, our Stroll Run or Roll events raised a total of \$15,000 with donations supporting a myriad of funds, programs and activities in the two communities – all as designated by each individual participant.

## Running for Shelter Team Raises \$1 Million for Affordable Housing

Many years ago, a team was put together to support affordable housing in the Hood to Coast Relay, the largest relay race in the world. Twenty-five years later, “Running for Shelter” ran one last team the 200 miles down the mountain and to the Pacific Ocean – to support National Church Residences and the Horizon Housing Foundation.

This team raised \$100,000 in 2022 – and a total of \$1 million over the history of running this race. Team members from the affordable housing field included Michelle Norris, National Church Residences; Kimberlee Cornett, Robert Wood Johnson Foundation; Dana Bourland, JPB Foundation; Paul Cummings, National Affordable Housing Trust (NAHT); Lowel Krueger, Yakima Housing Authority; Neal Drumm, Silicon Valley Bank; and Chris Hite (fundraising co-chair), Sugar Creek Capital.

This relay race in Oregon, deemed the “Mother of All Relays,” starts at 6,000 feet up Mt. Hood, runs through downtown Portland, and then over the coastal range out to the City of Seaside on the Pacific Ocean. The teams keep a baton moving – straight through the night – with each runner running three legs with an average distance of 5-6 miles each, so 15-18 miles total over 24 hours. Running for Shelter finished the race averaging just over 8 minute miles and finishing 121st overall out of over 1,000 finishing teams.

Major donors in 2022 included Enterprise, Bellwether, Cinnaire and NEF. ### GROVER MELLIGAN BRISTOL VILLAGE

Grover Melligan was a resident of Bristol Village for 24 years. He especially enjoyed the wood working studio there. In fact, he built all of the furniture in his home! Grover was a retired Army defense engineer, a U.S. Army veteran, a 1958 graduate of Virginia Polytechnic Institute, and a lifetime member of VFW Post 5193 in Belvidere, New Jersey. Service was important to him, and Grover had a deep love for his community. After his beloved wife passed, Grover changed his will to leave his estate to the Bristol Village Foundation. He viewed this gift as a way to give back and ensure the greatest needs at Bristol Village would be tended to – for his friends, neighbors and future residents of his community.

**MARTHA WHEELER**  
**FIRST COMMUNITY VILLAGE**

A longtime resident of First Community Village, Martha Wheeler was the “third generation” in her family to call First Community Village home. Martha and her husband, CW, moved to the Village in 1989. Preceding Martha were her grandparents, parents and in-laws. Always thinking of others, and how to make a difference in her community, Martha quickly became involved with the Village, serving on various committees, becoming the Village Mayor and then later a Board Member. Martha’s bequest of \$50,000 was directed to the Sustaining Fund of First Community Village Foundation – a fund

established in 1976 to provide financial assistance to residents who have outlived their financial resources. Martha’s bequest was a natural expression of how she lived her life: to positively impact those around her and into the future.



**ROBERT MERKLE**  
**FIRST COMMUNITY VILLAGE**

A retired petroleum engineer with a career spanning more than three decades and a widower of 24 years, Robert Merkle was a seven-year resident of First

Community Village. An outdoor enthusiast and avid hiker with more than 5,000 miles “logged,” Bob valued the active and enriched living experience that First Community Village provided him so much that he expressed his gratitude with a truly transformational gift. By far the largest bequest that the First Community Village Foundation has received, Bob’s gift in excess of \$1 million is strengthening the Foundation’s Sustaining Fund, has developed a Sensory Garden (see photo below) and provides for future Foundation mission impact.

## Grove City Manor Recovers from Hurricane Ian with Support from Volunteers

However, the state is also susceptible to hurricanes, which left the residents of Grove City Manor in Englewood, Florida temporarily displaced after the devastation of Hurricane Ian in September of 2022. Following an urgent call to action from the National Church Residences Foundation team, the dedicated staff of National Church Residences rallied to assist residents of Grove City Manor in returning to their homes. These committed employees traveled from Columbus, Ohio to Sarasota, Florida with only one week's notice to help residents rebuild their lives. They helped with moving boxes, setting up beds and arranging things in the apartments for residents. Residents were overjoyed to return home and to be greeted by many helping hands.



## LeadingAge and the Resident Emergency Fund Respond to Resident Needs After Hurricane Ian

Thanks to LeadingAge and your support of the Resident Emergency Fund, residents of Grove City Manor got relief after their homes were devastated by Hurricane Ian.

While some residents were able to leave the area with the help of family, others rode out the storm, hunkered down in their apartments. Once staff was able to get to the property, residents, whose apartments were flooded and damaged, were evacuated to hotels 3 hours away. Your support of the Resident Emergency Fund provided meals, toiletries and entertainment books for the residents for their first 4 days in their temporary homes, before other aid arrived on the scene. Once residents returned home, the Resident Emergency Fund provided each resident with a \$100 gift card.

LeadingAge stepped in with a gift of \$10,000 for the residents. The LeadingAge gift provided welcome baskets containing items such as paper towels, cleaning supplies and basics to get started in their new homes. The LeadingAge funds are also assisting with the replacement of the community computers and community room furniture, which were all destroyed in the hurricane. The computers and furniture provide the residents with an opportunity to gather together for meals and activities and to connect with family members via the internet.

Residents were overjoyed to return home to newly renovated apartments and assistance with moving back in during March and April 2023 – six long months after the hurricane. (For information on volunteers who helped move residents back into their homes in March and April, please see the story above.)

Many employees were unable to leave on a moment's notice to assist with the move in, but many wanted to help. Volunteer Services launched a Christmas in July program from the Central Office employees in Columbus, Ohio to purchase Walmart gift cards for residents. Every resident received a gift card to assist with replacing some of their lost items.

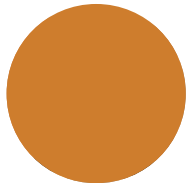

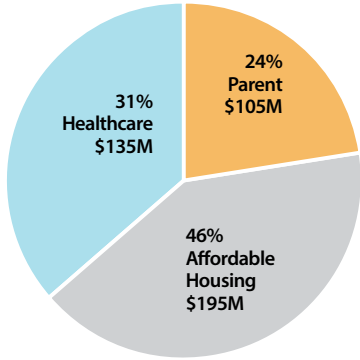

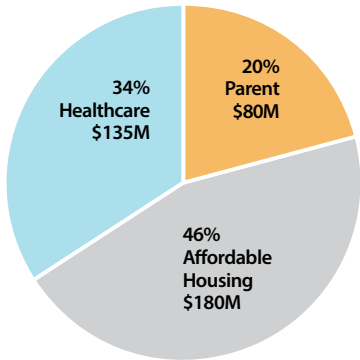

### Financial Snapshot

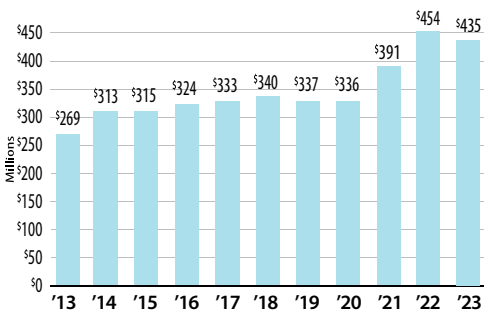
#### 2023 REVENUE



#### 2023 EXPENSES



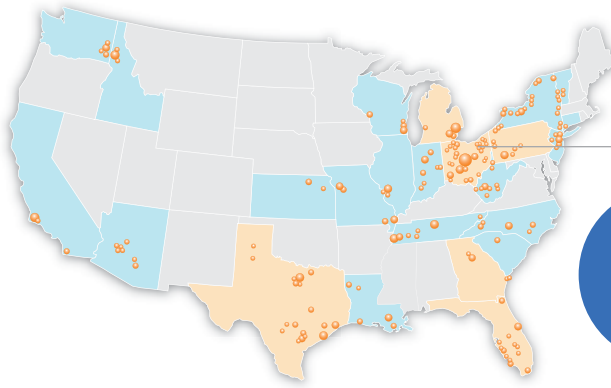
#### CONSOLIDATED REVENUE
